Reviewers' Comments:*Reviewer 1:**Dear author:**Thank you for submission of this article:**There are some notes:**Totally this article has valuable information on resistance pattern of enterobacteriaceae but there are grammatical problems and some sentences are confusing.**1- Introduction: the sentence "From a number of Enterobacteriaceae in various communities in the world have been identified gram-negative bacteria that produce ESBL" is confusing.**2- Objective: in sentence "This study aims to investigate the prevalence of transport of ESBL-producing Enterobacteriaceae among school children in South Sulawesi, Indonesia." This study is not going to investigate the transportation of resistance but this is a study on the prevalence of ESBL gene in organisms.**3- Site and sampling:**4- Were the study was performed one school or more than one, sampling method cannot be voluntarily, what was the characteristic of samples, did they have previous problems, using antibiotic or not and what was their age range.**5- Discussion: a big part of text has one reference please check it. Please describe what are your reason of similarity of your results with other author's results. Please give other examples of countries from different places of world with different socioeconomic status or other medical practices.**6- Please give a table to show the epidemiologic results with resistance genes**7- Did the author confirmed the organisms phenotypically?**8- Please separate the conclusion part.**Best thanks**Reviewer 2:**Dear editor,**cefotaxime (CTX-M), temoneira (TEM), and sulphydryl (SHV) change to Cefotaximases (CTX-M), temoniera (TEM), and sulphydryl variable (SHV).**Please add keywords based on MESH.**"bla" in the name of genes should be in italic form.**Please add the percentage and number in the abstract.**What is the reference for bacterial detection?**CAT No. and the producer company names for used materials has not been mentioned.**The standard strain number should be added in the methods and materials (for ESBL).**Why MIC was not performed according to CLSI guidelines?.*

Sequencing method should perform to confirm the PCR accuracy.
Statistical analysis should be added to the manuscript.
The discussion is poorly written.
The article type is shot communication.
