I think you should do your research with at least 30 MDR TB isolates to make your research more reliable (If it is available) 3- Please check References and correct them in the same format of paper 4- 1.5 x 108 is not correct please correct it 5- you should not use your own language in the manuscript such as in table 1 (simplisia , rendamen) Please write them in English

Reviewer Comment 2 :

Does author try using extracted compound separate from TLC or fraction collection to test for MIC as this would be much more interesting result. On identification of functional group any chance to do those with more sophisticate techniques such as mass spectrometer or even NMR. What about Stability of each extract this did not mention in this article. Some extracted compounds may susceptible to light, temperature and this can alter the result and interpretation.
