Your revisions have improved the paper, thank you. I have noted some minor corrections and a few queries. When these are addressed, I think the paper would be acceptable for publication. Personally, I'm not especially convinced by the analytical framework as you've explained it, and I wonder how useful it really is in an analysis of Indonesian smallholder decision-making. I'm aware of other literature on this topic from mainland SE Asia that I think offers less ideologically-framed analysis - see eg Kallio, M.H., Hogarth, N.J., Moeliono, M., Brockhaus, M., Cole, R., Bong, I.W., Wong, G.Y., 2018.
