Significant original work and novel results. (4)

Research method is not easily identified, but only partially appropriate to address the problem (4)

Future Impact: Future impact on related subject of the research/society.

Future impact is defined but not very clear; the likely impact is relevant to some research/society (4)

The Clarity of Research Question: The clarity of research question/problem and relevance of the literature overview

Problem can be identified, and related to literature review (4)

Scientific argument and discussion: - The strength of argument and discussion in connecting research finding with original research question. - The summary and conclusions (indicating to what degree the problem has been solved)

Standard arguments that only partially support the conclusion (3)

The number of words is still less than 1881, at least 3500 words, too few abstracts, no discussion, only 11 references, fig.3 and fig.7 are not clear. Note: If the article is not revised, we will not publish the article even though you have attended a parallel session. The revised version of the article should be submitted no more than October 18th, 2022.

Some interesting ideas and results on a subject well investigated. (3)

Research method is not clearly identified, but inappropriateness is not evident (3)

Future impact is not explicitly defined; the likely impact is limited (3)

Problem is incompletely reported, and the relevance to literature review is not clear (3)

Good discussion with adequate evidence to support conclusion (4)

This article needs to be improved in terms of increasing the number of words which is only 1881 words, too few abstracts, no discussion, references to only 11 items, and in fig.3 and fig.7 it is not clear. If the article is not revised, we will not publish the article even though you have attended the parallel session. The revised version of the article should be submitted no more than October 18th, 2022

Minor variations on a well investigated subject. (2)

Research method is not clearly identified, but inappropriateness is not evident (3)

Future impact is not defined; the likely impact is questionable (2)

The Clarity of Research Question: The clarity of research question/problem and relevance of the literature overview

Problem is incompletely reported, and the relevance to literature review is not clear (3)

Scientific argument and discussion: - The strength of argument and discussion in connecting research finding with original research question. - The summary and conclusions (indicating to what degree the problem has been solved)

Conclusions are not supported by decent discussion (2)

Detailed Comments: Please justify your recommendation and suggest improvements in technical content or presentation.

The content of the paper is good enough, but there are still revisions needed. On the introduction part, please mention clearly the aim of the research; explain the urgency and novelty; and add a few references.

The method should be completed by clear description about the participants of the study, instrument used, the data analysis technique, and the research procedures.

For the technical quality of the paper, the figures shown should be in a good quality. The result and discussion of the paper should be elaborated more with the differentiation compared to previous researches (minimum 30 references). The paper should be consist of minimum 3500 words. Don't forget to use the IEEE style citation technique. Avoid using referrals from websites. In addition, please make sure the references used are only those published in 2012-2022.
