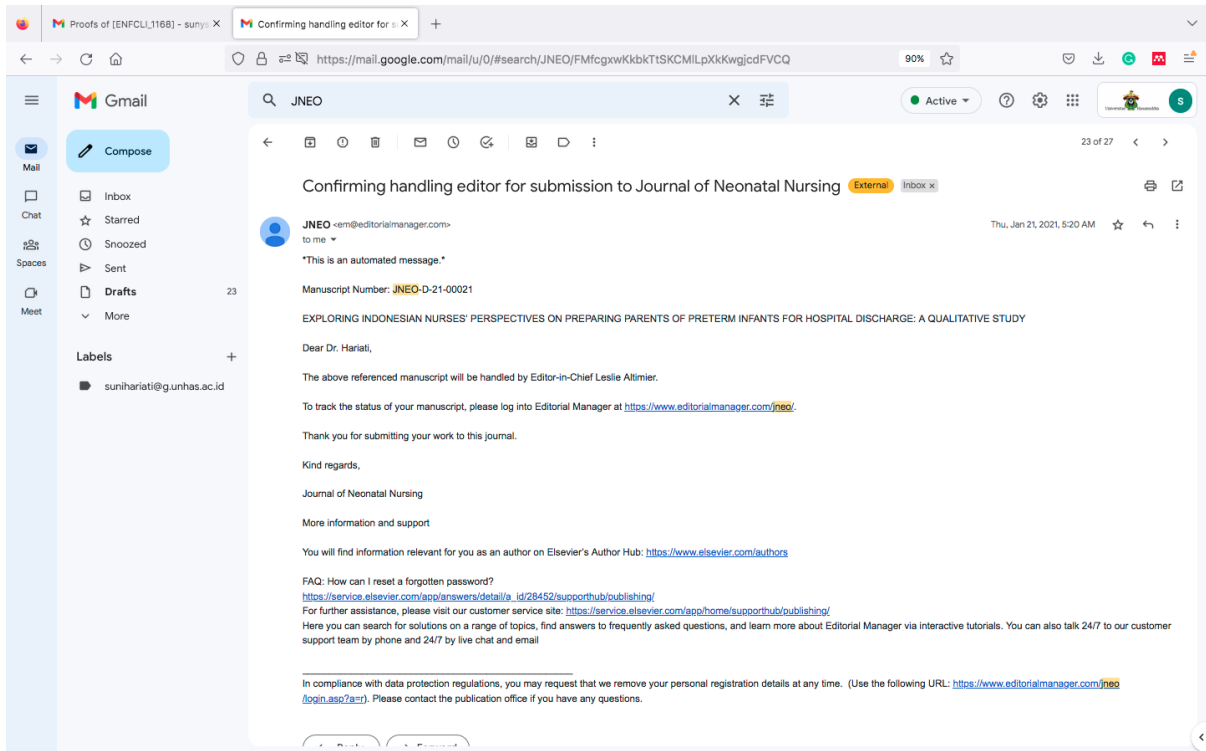
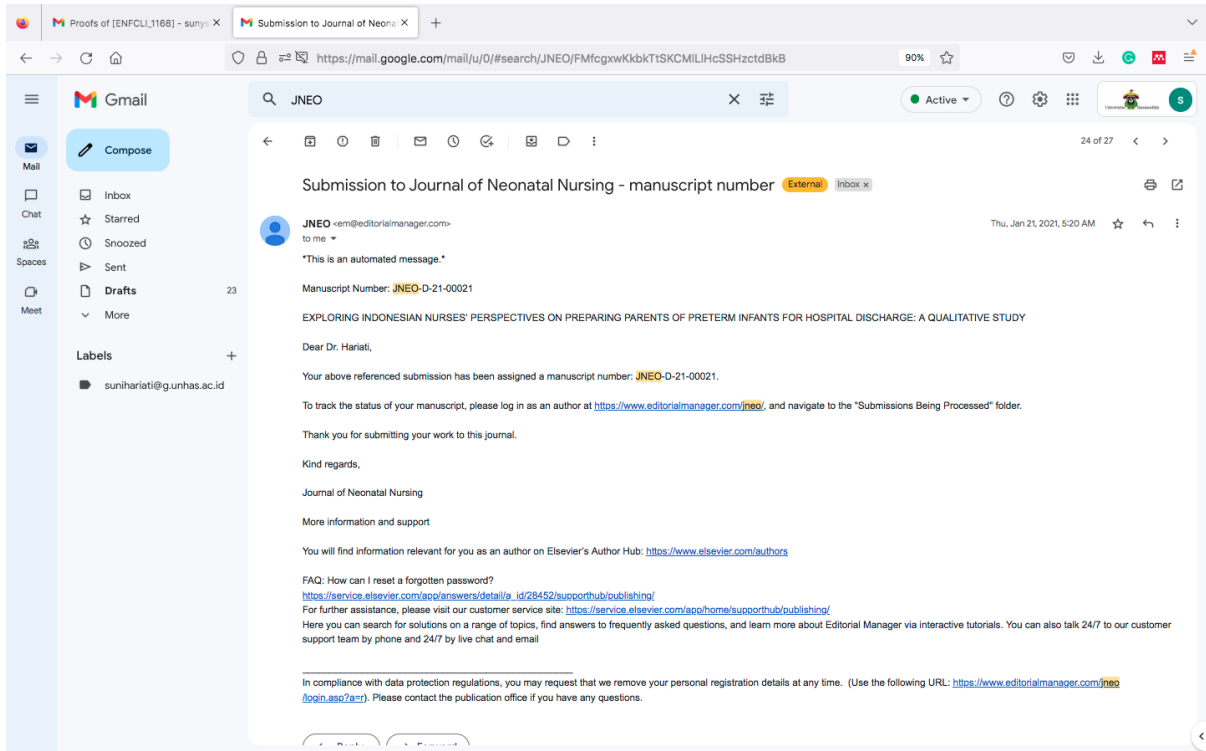

Reviewer #2: The focus of the study was worthy of investigation. However, the manuscript would be strengthened if the following areas (below) were addressed.

- It is not clear what kind of interviews were conducted - semi-structured or in-depth? The second and the third theme sound very vague.
- Language and many grammatical issues throughout the manuscript; proof reading is needed.
