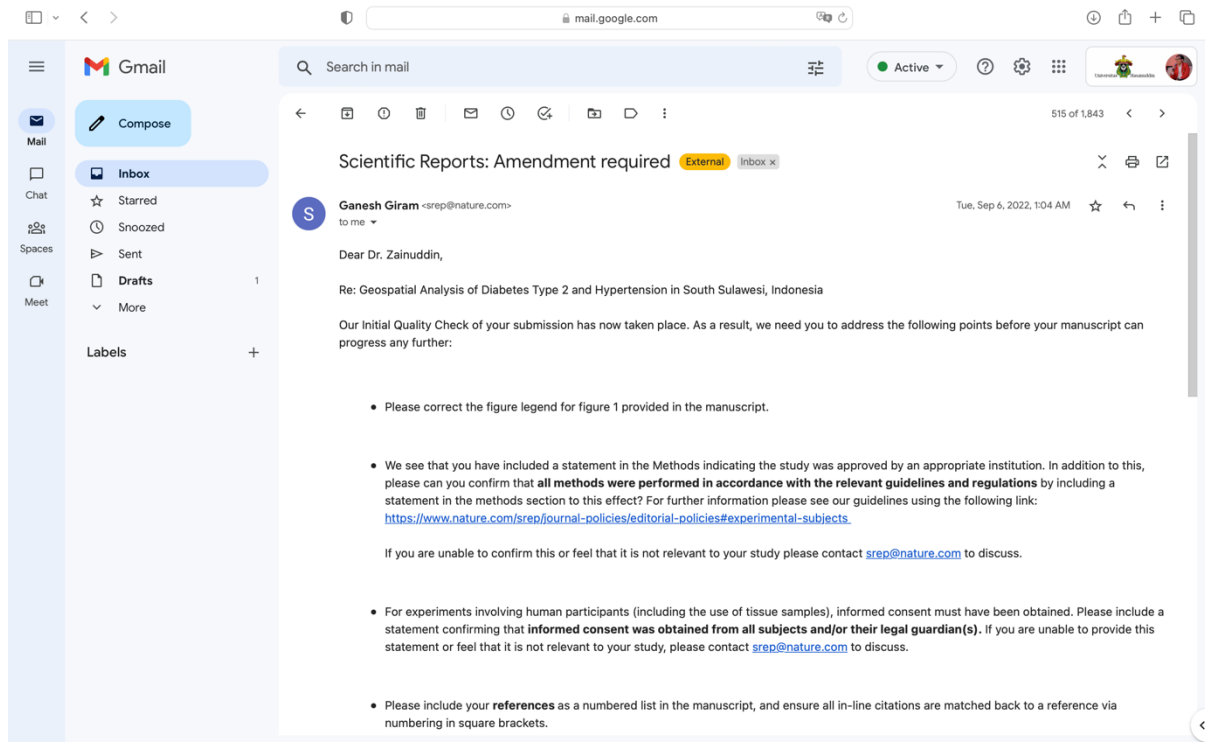
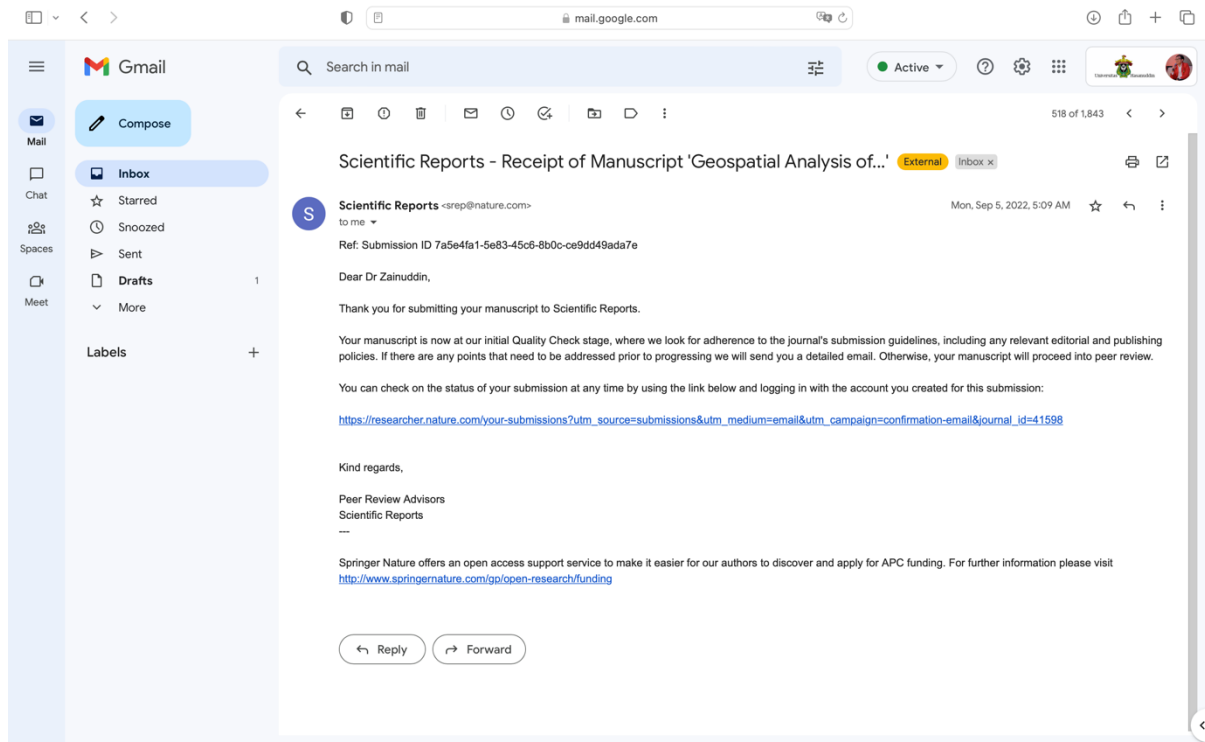

Reviewer Comments:

Reviewer 1
Reviewer comments

- The manuscript needs major English editing regarding grammar, spelling, fluency, and punctuation.
- Figures 1 and 3 resolution is low and new high-resolution figures should be provided.
- Table 1: unit of values in columns 2 and 3 should be added.
- Figure 3, legend: "Hypertension" should be corrected.
- The discussion section should be revised and discusses findings of similar studies and include more updated references.
- Reference citations in the text should be corrected in line square brackets.

Reviewer 2

This is an interesting manuscript that applied spatial statistical methods to the analysis of district-level data on diabetes in a province in Indonesia. While this study has merit, I have identified a number of issues that I ask the authors to address.

- My biggest concern is about the small sample size (n=24) that will make the spatial statistical analysis results including hot spots analysis and spatial regression highly unreliable. By the way, the sample size and spatial unit of analysis should be reported in the Materials and Methods section.
- Descriptive statistics including mean, S.D., min, and max should be included in Table 1 and described in the methodology section.
- When reporting Global Moran's I in the last paragraph in page 18, p-value should also be reported to indicate if the degree of spatial autocorrelation was statistical significant.
- For the first time of use in the paper, ANOVA should be spelled out - analysis of variance. Moreover, the use of lower case or upper case for this statistical term should be consistent.
- The font size in Figure 1 and 3 are too small to be legible.
- The legend of Figure 2 is not intuitive enough that allows the readers to understand what the spatial unit of analysis and what the measurement unit are for the data of diabetes. Besides, a jargon like INCDM2 should not be used in the legend.
- For figure 4, it is necessary to explain what the numbers in parentheses in the legend represent. I suppose they represent the numbers of observations or districts within the context of their neighboring features that had statistically higher prevalence rates than the study area as a whole.
